Rare Non-Breeding, Migratory, and Wintering Bird Species:

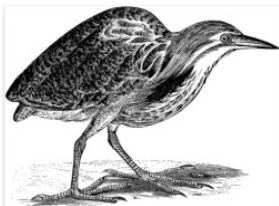

LANDBIRDS – The state is mainly documenting sightings of listed birds during the breeding season. However they are also documenting non-breeding/migratory/wintering sightings of a number of species, some of which only migrate through NJ. These are:

WATERBIRDS – The state is mainly documenting active nests of listed birds, but they are also documenting non-breeding/migratory/wintering sightings of:



Pied-billed Grebe
American Bittern
Least Bittern

Tricolored Heron
Black-crowned Night-Heron
Yellow-crowned Night-Heron
